WSP86/18 Devon Air Ambulance – update from Toby Russell

I too would like to see things moving along given the time investment so far, but these planning matters cannot easily be resolved. In simple terms I don't have several documents they are asking for.

Referring to their points, in particular:

- 2) we do not have scaled drawings on the columns at the site. A contractor would need to be employed by yourselves to do that.
- 4) we do not have lighting plans for the site either with the current or future lighting, again someone specialised would need to draw up those plans.

Its seems to me that our original thought of this being easy is not so when it comes to dealing with the planners at Teignbirdge. Going forward options are: a) for CII Peart to speak to the planning team to see if there's an easy way around this or b) change the type of lighting used and go for the 'standard' lighting system used at other night landing sites which consists of a single 10m column and two lights on top. We can soon establish where that column should go for planning purposes.

If we go for option b) we can provide scaled drawings of the column, lighting info etc. All documents, apart from the location plan, that would need to be submitted with a planning application. I can quite quickly ask MAT Electrics to draw up a quote for that system. However, as requested previously I have still not seen a written quote for the access/gate works that Cllr.Peart was handling, and we can't establish full project costs until that is provided.

My gut feeling is revert to option (B) a system that is well known and used elsewhere but Cllr. Peart may well feel it's worth him speaking to the Teignbridge planners.

Wil wait to hear from you on next steps.

c) Stagecoach Bus – Newton Abbot timetable changes June, 2018 for information (information below)

STAGECOACH SOUTH WEST CONFIRMS CHANGES TO NEWTON ABBOT AREA TIMETABLES

- New timetables for routes 13 and 88 to start from Sunday 22 July
- Changes follow on from customer consultation earlier in the year
- Route 13 changes include new links to Kingsteignton & Torbay Hospital
- Route 88 to combine 70/77 to create 30 min cross town link

Stagecoach South West has confirmed that, starting 22 July, it will be introducing new timetables on its 13 and 88 bus routes.

They take into account new housing developments in the area and changing travel patterns, alongside customer feedback following a public consultation earlier in the year.

Route 13

Route 13 will extend to Kingsteignton to provide additional capacity during busy times and create new, direct links to The Willows, Torbay Hospital, South Devon College and Brixham. Journeys from Newton Abbot towards Aller will serve Torquay Road and East Street instead of the train station.

There will be changes to the route between Brixham, Paignton and Torbay Hospital to restore many of the links previously provided by Local Link route 67. Buses between Brixham and South Devon College will run on their existing route. After this, they will then use Waterleat Avenue, Colley End Road, Paignton Bus Station and Marldon Road. Customers for Foxhole can connect onto the 'Fox' at Colley End Road and Marldon Road.

Brixham departure times will coordinate with our 18A service. To make the connection as easy as possible, the bus stop is moving from Bolton Street to Bank Lane so buses stop right next to each other.

Buses will run hourly throughout the day instead of every 2 hours and the current variations for particular school and college flows will remain in place.

Route 88

The new route 88 timetable merges routes 70 and 77 in order to create a cross town route that runs every 30 minutes between Buckland and Mile End. Buses then continue to Ashburton and Totnes every hour creating new links to the railway station.

New timetables will shortly be available online and in print. Customers can also download the free Stagecoach app - available in the App and Play stores - or use the website journey planner to plan their journeys. New timetable information will be available via the app or journey planner from week commencing 2 July 2018.
