Mr Phil Banner advised that Cllr Ripping had requested that consideration be given to whether or not the Council should provide commemorative mugs to all Kingsteignton Primary School pupils to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. Mr Phil Banner further advised that some preliminary quotes had been obtained with costs ranging from between £2,149 and £5,914 net of VAT.
