82/2022 Clifford Park – update

Following the pre start meeting with the Contractor for the installation of the new Play Equipment, attention was drawn to the three Springers in the play area, which were marked for remaining. It was noted that the three Springers in situ were failing and Proludic were asked to provide the Town Council with a price to replace these and 20mm overlay in the surfacing for them. Surfacing under the large climbing frame was also looked at and needs overlaying.

I have spoken with Ben Jones, Proludic and a quote for this additional work should be received shortly prior to the meeting and will be forwarded to councillors at that time.

Ben Jones has done some estimating on what the cost would be which is as follows:



- To remove existing springers, supply, deliver and install new Springers (a car, a bike and a lion)
- Total areas requiring skimming with the Junior Multi-play Unit and springers is 105m2 – this needs to be confirmed by the designer and priced by the rubber company but this will be in the region of £9,900
- The Junior Multi-play Unit pad has sunk in some areas and will need 6m2 of rubber removed, 100 mm of stone compacted before the rubber is laid to this area at around £400. The Springer pads will need to be extended slightly to confirm to new standards at around £200.

For everything discussed Ben estimates that the council would be looking at around £15,000 excluding vat.

Proludic have provided an example of a Play Area Notice to go on the new site when it is completed.
