# What is the funding?

This is allocated funding from Teignbridge District Council.

This funding is available to enable Town and Parish Councils to take forward their own ideas to improve the cleanliness of their local area, which will complement the street cleaning activities already provided by Teignbridge District Council.

To deliver benefit to the local community in the following ways:

- Enhance current local area cleaning activities
- Improve cleanliness of local areas to make Teignbridge a better place to live and work
- Improving the appearance of the local area to increase pride in the community

#### What does the funding cover?

Innovation and new ideas are welcomed but some examples of what this money can be used for are:

- Non-mechanical cleaning equipment
- Staff costs for additional cleaning work
- Community awareness and clean up action days
- Graffiti removal
- Litter picks
- Screening works and materials
- Additional training
- Promotional materials

#### What is not covered?

- Cleaning activities already being carried out by the Town/Parish Council or Teignbridge District Council
- Mechanical equipment
- Street litter or dog waste bins
- The purchase of weed killing chemicals or spraying equipment

Items that are not covered by this fund may be covered by the <u>Devon County Council Localities</u> fund.

How much funding is available? 2023/24 - £40,000

#### Is there a limit on the size of funding request?

Grants of up to £2,000 per Town/Parish Council are available, however we anticipate that many grants will be for much less than this.

#### Can more than one grant application be submitted?

Kingsteignton Town Council has declared a 'Climate Emergency'

Only one grant application can be submitted. Town/Parish councils can apply for funding in 2023/2024, regardless of whether they made a successful bid in 2022/2023. Applications can be submitted to continue a successful scheme from 2022/2023 or for a new activity.

#### Will the project be monitored?

We will ask for feedback on progress halfway through the project in October 2023 and a final project update following the end of the project in April 2024. We may also ask for evidence of spend to be demonstrated. If a proposed project or activity cannot be delivered and the allocated funding is not spent on specified goods or services before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024 you will be asked to return the underspend to Teignbridge District Council.

#### Good afternoon

Having recently moved into Potters Lea, the second phase of the Moorland Reach development, we find the above service to be very useful.

However, the bus stop serving the new estates is located on Exeter Road to which none of the estate properties has direct access. It is, in fact, quite remote from many of the dwellings. Further, the stop not only lacks a shelter but is, in certain conditions, vulnerable to spray from the frequent HGV traffic on that road.

I appreciate the estate roads have yet to be adopted but once this has happened, I suggest the bus route be slightly altered to run through the estate, entering from Exeter Road at Heron Way and exiting from Robin Way with an appropriate stop.

This would greatly enhance the accessibility and attractiveness of the service.
